Despite the COVID 19 pandemic the GROW BIOINTENSIVE Agriculture Centre of Kenya has continued to attract hundreds of farmers and farmer groups in Kenya and beyond for training and empowerment at the G-BIACK centre. Since January 2021, more than 500 farmers have come to our centre to be trained in GROW BIOINTENSIVE Agroecological practices.

In addition to farmers and farmer groups, G-BIACK has been involved in a major collaborative programme to expand the capacities of other civil societies and NGO's into the area of Agroecological agriculture so that they can bring regenerative, sustainable methods to their constituents and to farmers in their outreach.

This is all possible because of our qualified and very competent staff who are experienced in general Agroecological agriculture and even more specifically in the method we teach, GROW BIOINTENSIVE agriculture. Other advantages are that the centre has hostels that can host at least 35 people at a time, as well as other conference facilities like computers, a training hall and a kitchen. Our gardens are organized with about 280 growing double dug beds and a diversity of crops. The visiting trainees eat about 70% of the food grown at the centre therefore enjoying organically grown food. Additional food is purchased from farmers trained by G-BIACK so it is guaranteed that all food provided to our visitors is grown without synthetic chemicals.
