G-BIACK’s “Take a Rabbit Home Programme”

Orphans and children from vulnerable, severely impoverished families endure great hardship and suffer from hunger. G-BIACK’s “Take a Rabbit Home Programme” targets such children. The children are given a pregnant rabbit and trained to care for it. So far, 30 children have benefited from this programme. It is very successful because rabbits are easy to keep, and a child can do it competently and with pride. As the rabbits multiply, some can be eaten in order to add nutrition, especially protein, to the diet and some rabbits can be sold to pay school fees or enhance family finances. One rabbit brings ksh 1, 500 (about U.S. \$21). Rabbits reproduce very rapidly, so the children are able to develop a sustainable project that continuously increases in benefits and value over time.

After each donated rabbit gives birth, two of the young are donated back to the G-BIACK programme and are in turn given to other orphans and children in need. Using this revolving method, we are able to continuously expand the outreach of the project.
