**THE G-BIACK 2017 PLAN OF ACTION**



***Samuel and Peris Nderitu "Please help us to help the needy"***

After successfully completing the 2016 organizational activities, we have again started the New Year with new energy. All the G-BIACK staff and the board of trustees are ready to play their part and to make a strong team that will bring G-BIACK to the next level of development as we strive to build communities and to reduce extreme poverty among our people.

In the year 2017, G-BIACK will focus on the following general programmes

1. Continue piloting on a programme called satellites centres program SCP. We will continue to bring good farmers from different counties at our centre, train them on the GROW BIOINTENSIVE farming, and then send them back home to become satellite farmers. In 2016, we were able to train 38 farmers from 28 Counties out of the total 47.
2. Continue implementing The Girls Empowerment Program GEP that was initiated in 2016. This programme focuses on reaching out to young women who have dropped out of school and who are struggling in the villages due to lack of education and skills. The main areas of empowerment include agriculture, Textiles, Baking, and computer literacy.
3. Continue building the capacities of other NGOs that are not practicing good agricultural systems.
4. Reach out to more schools and help them to create gardens in a school feeding programme called Biointensive Agriculture for schools BAS program.
5. Continue with the implementation of a project to offer market avenues for our farmers' produce. After several years of training, many of our farmers are producing high quality organic farm produce. By partnering with us for value addition, they will compete favorably in the market.
