## Happy New Year!

2018 was a very successful year for the GROW BIOINTENSIVE Agriculture Centre of Kenya. Many activities were accomplished. G-BIACK is now at a higher level as compared to the past years. Together with a very able team of staff and our board members, it was possible to attain most of our program activity goals, the most important one being to assist our target communities to improve their livelihoods through maximum utilization of available resources.

G-BIACK is currently working with 11 selected communities in 3 counties (Muranga, Kiambu and Machakos).

In 2019, we shall focus on the following programmes

- 1. Building capacities of small holder farmers in agroecology and helping them become self-reliant in their agricultural activities.
- 2. Empower women and youth, majoring on young women who have dropped out of school, by offering skills that help them become self-reliant and community leaders.
- 3. Establish agricultural satellite Centres in different parts of the countries which will be used as farmers training centres but which are run by the farmers.
- 4. Continue building the capacities of other NGOs that are not practicing agroecology by offering them skills in good agricultural systems.
- 5. Reach out to more schools and orphanages and help them to create gardens in the school feeding programme.
