The GROW BIOINTENSIVE Agriculture Centre of Kenya has held strategic planning meetings for the year 2021. We will be working on two major projects with the farmers:

- 1. Scaling up the best Agro ecological agriculture and environmental conservation practices based on the GROW BIOINTENSIVE techniques – (2018-2022)**
- 2. Sustainable Livelihoods Through Improved Family Incomes, Nutrition and Self-sustainability (SLIFINS) Project - (2021-2024)**

These projects are targeting small holder farming communities in 5 counties; Kiambu, Muranga, Nyeri, Machakos and Kajiado. The projects will place more emphasis on training of farmers from selected communities on soil health, organic food production, seed saving, increased farm income, nutrition and value addition. As well, elements of environmental conservation will be scaled up, and **Agroforestry and tree planting** will strongly be emphasized in order to rehabilitate degraded areas.

**G-BIACK** targets to reach out to educate a minimum of 3000 farmers in 2021 through workshops, field days, farmer to farmer trainings and other avenues that will help to transfer knowledge. The Corona virus has devastated many families and their income and there are more needy farmers than ever before. To facilitate faster dissemination of knowledge, we envision an emphasis on working in partnership and collaboration with other likeminded organizations, and helping to establish mini ag Centres in the counties, schools and institutions of higher learning. This will facilitate quicker dissemination of organic food production.
