

## PLAN OF ACTION 2022

The demand for healthy eating and healthy living is increasing dramatically in rural Kenya. Despite the Corona virus pandemic which has continued to terrorize and destabilize normal living conditions of people all over the world, the year 2021 remains the year when G-BIACK trained the biggest number of farmers in a model known as demand driven model where farmers developed interest of learning and practicing the GROW BIOINTENSIVE agroecological farming techniques and healthy food growing practices. A total of 3,221 farmers were trained who came to G-BIACK after seeing GROW BIOINTENSIVE farms. Going forward in 2022, we plan to continue working on four major projects with the farmers:

1. Scaling up the best Agroecological agriculture and environmental conservation practices based on the GROW BIOINTENSIVE techniques
2. Sustainable Livelihoods Through Improved Family Incomes, Nutrition and Self sustainability (SLIFINS) Project which also targets women in Kenya
3. The Sustainable Livelihoods Expansion for farmers through GROW BIOINTENSIVE agriculture and food sovereignty - (SLEG-FS)
4. Collaborative project on farmers managed seed system in Kenya

These projects are targeting small holder farmers in 5 counties; Kiambu, Muranga, Nyeri, Machakos and Kajiado and have been placing emphasis on training of farmers on soil health, organic food production, seed saving, increased farm income, nutrition and value addition and organic marketing. As well, elements of environmental conservation, Agroforestry and tree planting are strongly emphasized in order to rehabilitate degraded areas.
