

### **G-BIACK DEVELOPMENT– 2009-2015**

G-BIACK began operating in 2009 and has grown strategically and organically to date. October 2015 marked exactly 7 years since its inception. Our organization's main emphasis has been on training farmers in organic GROW BIOINTENSIVE (GB) agriculture techniques and other ecologically friendly farm and home practices. Over this time it has established a training centre with a successful women and youth programme that is giving young people, women in particular, skills to enable them to engage in meaningful employment or self-employment.

G-BIACK started with two staff members, Samuel and Peris Nderitu (Founders). To date, there are eight agricultural trainers, three women program trainers and an accounts officer. The organization has cumulatively trained a total of 12, 297 farmers using very meager resources. This has been possible through partnership with several players both local and international. G-BIACK has 3 training halls, an office space for the staff, a nutrition classroom, and a library. The organization is in the process of expanding our hostel that will host up to 30 farmers.

G-BIACK's purpose is to reach out to the less privileged communities with knowledge that will impact them in terms of food and income generation. The long term goal is to seed a sense of Empowerment and self reliance that leads to improved food sovereignty and livelihoods and a healthier, continuously improving environment
