Solidaridad Farmers Training at G-BiACK!



The farmers toured the centre, learned about who we are and what we do. This was also the time we introduced them to the GROW BIOINTENSIVE Agriculture technique, which is a highly practical, inexpensive, and organic approach based on principles that improve soil fertility and yields by working with nature rather than against it. The farmers then experienced hands-on demonstrations and engaged in open discussions of the 8 core principles of GROW BIOINTENSIVE and how these could be applied to increase productivity and sustainability on their farms.



Composting and Planting

This week, farmers got hands-on experience with two key Grow Biointensive practices: close planting and compost making. During the session, they learned how close spacing helps create a living mulch, which conserves moisture, suppresses weeds, and increases yields in small plots.

hey also participated in building compost piles using locally available materials, gaining practical skills on how to turn farm and kitchen waste into rich organic fertilizer. These activities are essential steps toward building healthy soil and improving food production in a sustainable way.
