

# Farmers Exchange Visit

The farmer exchange visit began with members of the Ndonyo Community traveling to Githima Community on 3rd July 2025 to learn from their farming practices, share experiences, and explore locally-driven solutions in sustainable agriculture. This initial visit fostered valuable peer learning and strengthened the relationship between the two communities. Building on that exchange, the Ndonyo farmers later visited G-BiACK, where they toured the demonstration farm and engaged in an interactive dialogue on the Seed and Plant Varieties Act (Cap 326), indigenous seed conservation, seed sovereignty, and the vital role of farmers in shaping sustainable food systems.


