The Youth Empowerment Program came alive with a lively Games Day that promoted teamwork and fun. The activity gave young people an energising space to connect and grow through healthy competition.

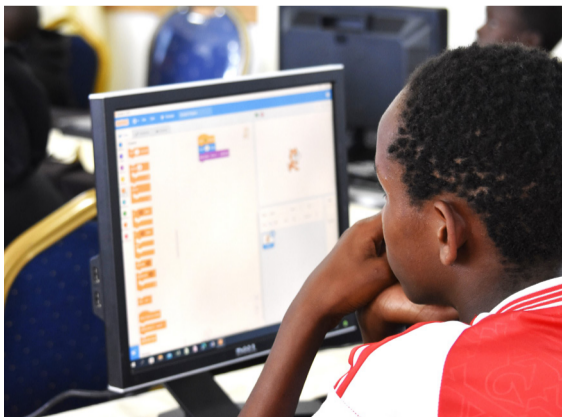
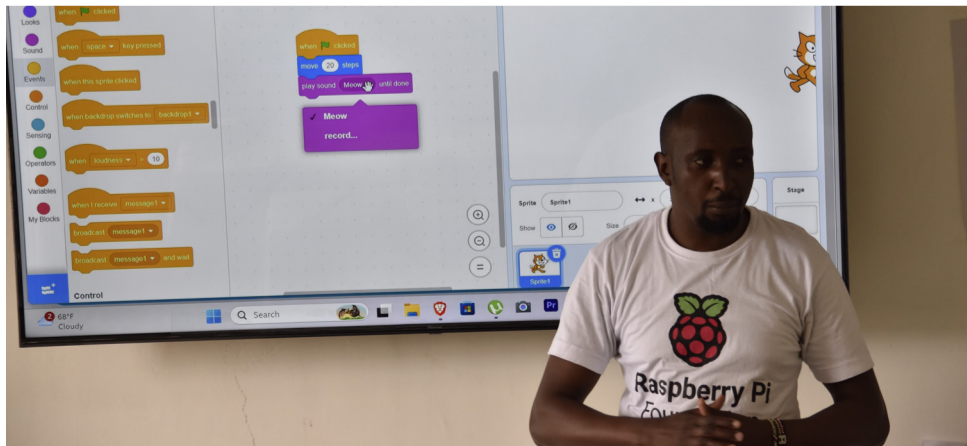
